



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q: What is the United Way of Cass-Clay School Supply Drive?

A: The School Supply Drive (SSD) is an annual project that creates lasting change in our community by providing a new backpack and a basic set of school supplies to children in Cass and Clay counties. **Last year, 5,854 children were equipped with supplies.** Over **500 volunteers** from businesses, organizations and individuals donated a tremendous amount of supplies and time to help students in our community be confident and prepared for school.

Q: How can I donate backpacks & supplies?

A: Donation drop-off sites will be open Tuesday, July 11 – noon Friday, July 28.

New backpacks and school supplies can be dropped off at the following sites:
